### Afternoon Performances:

Doors will open at 1.50pm and admittance will be with your ticket.

### Evening Performances:

Children should return to school at 5.45pm, ready dressed in their costumes, and assemble in their classrooms - please bring YR children to the Reception classroom door and Y1 and Y2 children to their cloakroom entrance door. KS2 children must enter through their normal KS2 entrance doors. The KS1 performance will finish at approximately 6.30pm and KS2 will finish at approximately 7.00pm. Please arrange for your child to be collected at the end of the performances if you are not attending. No child will be allowed to leave unaccompanied. If you are attending a performance, please note admittance will be through the Main Entrance with your ticket. Doors will open at 5.50pm.

Children will need to bring their costumes back into school for the next performance

Grandparents are invited to the performances as detailed above on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December and can request up to 2 tickets per performance.

In the interests of fairness and compliance with performance/health and safety regulations, all tickets will be limited to **two per family for each Key Stage** as appropriate (not each performance). The procedure to request tickets is shown on the attached.

**Admittance will be by ticket only through the main school entrance, please remember to bring your tickets with you. Doors open at 1.50pm for afternoon performances and 5.50pm for evening performances. Please do not arrive early as there will be no access into the school.**

At the end of each performance there will be a collection for St Giles Hospice, a local charity caring for people with incurable illnesses and providing bereavement support.

**Please switch mobile phones off or switch to silent** to maximise everyone's enjoyment and do not use flash photography during the performance as this can distract the children. Photos and videos can be taken & kept as family mementos but **must not be shared on any form of social media** as we have children whose image cannot be in the public domain
